

By registering my child(ren) for this enrichment class through J at School, I agree to the following:

I grant permission for my child to attend the program(s) on the selected date(s) and release JCC Chicago of all responsibility other than reasonable care. I have read and agree with JCC Registration Policies (available at <http://www.jccchicago.org/policies/>.)

I give my permission for my child's picture to be used for publicity purposes by JCC Chicago. This is including, but not limited to: the JCC website, publicity materials, and J at School and JCC social media accounts. I understand that JCC has the right to cap the program or make changes at any time. All updates or changes will be communicated via email. Minimum enrollment must be met for class to run. No refunds will be granted unless class does not run.

If my child is *not* registered for After Care, I agree to pick my child up promptly at the end of her/his enrichment class. I understand that, should I arrive later than 15 minutes after the end of the class, my child will be absorbed into the After Care program and I will be charged the drop-in rate for the day.

Behavior Policy

The goal of our J at School enrichment programming is to create an environment in which all students feel supported to learn and explore. In order to enjoy a successful and safe day at our enrichment programs, students are expected to adhere to their school Code of Conduct, and to respect and follow the expectations of the class instructors. In turn, enrichment instructors are required to follow the same guidelines, and to manage behavior and resolve conflict using positive reinforcement techniques. Instructors may use a variety of techniques to manage inappropriate and/or disruptive behavior during enrichment classes; these techniques might include redirection, positive reinforcement, sticker charts/reward systems, calming techniques, and/or mediated discussion. Instructors are responsible for communicating with parents about these incidents and may choose to involve the Enrichment Manager to determine an appropriate behavior management plan for the student when deemed necessary.

In cases of extreme and/or continued unsafe and/or disruptive behavior during class, instructors have the right to dismiss students from the class and/or require parents to pick up immediately. Repeated disruptive and/or extremely unsafe behavior will result in the student being removed from the class permanently. A refund will not be provided in these situations.

It is J at School's goal to maintain and promote a safe and nurturing environment for all students involved in our programming. Our priority is to support and engage our students, families, and school communities through open communication and positive, purposeful interaction.
